A certified check or cashier's check made payable to the Parsippany-Troy Hills Board of Fire Commissioners-Fire District 1, or a duly executed bid bond in the amount of 10% of each bid, but in no case in excess of \$20,000.00, must be deposited by the bidder together with a Certificate of Surety evidencing that he can obtain the required Performance and Payment Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the total amount of the contract.

The successful bidder shall be required to deliver to the Board an executed Performance and Payment Bond of the responsible indemnity company authorized to do business in the State of New Jersey.
