## **CONDITIONS**

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:5A-10 and 11 of the Local Authorities Fiscal Control Law and N.J.A.C. 5:31-2.1 et seq., each Authority in the State of New Jersey is required to submit a budget for each fiscal year to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for review and approval. In accordance with these statutory and regulatory requirements, the Parsippany-Troy Hills Fire District #1 submitted its introduced budget for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2022 to the Director for review and approval.

During the review of the 2022 budget for the Fire District, it was concluded that the Fire District is holding a referendum question at the annual election in February for two fire truck financing with a down-payment in the amount of \$305,000. If the voters do not approve the capital referendum, the down-payment would be amended to the future capital outlay appropriation line item. In addition, the Fire District is amending their introduced 2022 budget. The Fire District may amend their budget then proceed to adopt their 2022 budget. The certified amendment must be forwarded when the adopted budget is submitted.
